

Egptian royal servants thought to be the first documented gays. They held hands, embraced each other, & were buried together.








Those in Howaiian culture with both male & female spirit. Seen as the 3th gender, this is an expression of a 3rd self.





Mexican people born as male that do not identify as such. Zapotec cultures view this as the 3rd gender.
