Peer pressure is when someone encourages you to do something that you don't feel comfortable doing. It is usually something that would get you in trouble if an adult were around. Read the examples below to identify if they describe peer pressure!

5. OLIVE MISSES THE BUS TO SCHOOL. SANDY SAYS, "YOU CAN RIDE WITH ME AND MY MOM IF YOU WANT TO. I'M SURE IT'LL BE OK." IS THIS PEER PRESSURE? • YES • NO
WHY OR WHY NOT?
